TWO VEHICLE CRASH WITH ENTRAPMENT in FOREST PARK

City of Forest Park, July 10th, 2019 –Forest Park Chief of police Bill Arns and Hamilton County Sheriff Jim Neil reports a two vehicle crash that occurred in the 1200 block of W. Kemper Road in the City of Forest Park on July 10th, 2019 at 4:56 a.m.

A 2017 Terex Advance concrete mixer, was being operated by Rene Webb, male, age 54, of Hamilton, Ohio eastbound on W. Kemper Rd near Warrior Way. Mr. Webb stopped his truck in the lane of travel and turned on flashers to look for the entrance to a construction site where he was to deliver concrete. A 2006 Chrysler PT Cruiser, operated by Nancy Welch, female, age 59, of Cincinnati, was traveling eastbound on W. Kemper Rd approaching the concrete truck from the rear. Ms. Welch's vehicle struck the rear of the concrete truck and became lodged underneath.

Ms. Welch was mechanically extricated from her vehicle by the City of Forest Park Fire Department. She was trapped for approximately 50 minutes. She was then transported to University Hospital by Air care where she is in critical condition.

Ms. Webb was wearing a seatbelt at the time of the crash. Alcohol and speed are not believed to be factors in the crash.

The crash remains under investigation by the Sheriff's Traffic Safety Unit.
