VEHICLE PURSUIT IN ANDERSON TOWNSHIP

Anderson Township, August 1, 2019 – Hamilton County Sheriff Jim Neil reports a vehicle pursuit that began in Anderson Township at 5:52AM on Clough Pike at Wanninger Lane, which ended with an arrest on Colter Ave in the City of Cincinnati.

A 2013 Nissan Versa, which was operated by Samuel J Willman II, male DOB 06/14/1995, was witnessed making a traffic infraction by a deputy near Eight Mile Road and Clough Pike. The deputy attempted to initiate a traffic stop where Mr. Willman failed to comply with the deputy. Mr. Willman led the deputies on a brief pursuit where he exited his vehicle on Colter Ave. and fled into a dark wooded area. Mr. Willman was apprehended by a deputy after a brief foot chase and was tased by the deputy.

Mr. Willman was taken into custody without further incident and was treated on scene by the Cincinnati Fire Department. Mr. Willman had a felony warrant out of Clermont County for Aggravated Drug Possession and was charged for failure to comply, obstruction official business, resisting arrest, driving under suspension along with minor traffic violations. Mr. Williams was transported to the Hamilton County Justice Center.
