SERIOUS INJURY CRASH AT MOELLER HIGH SCHOOL

Sycamore Township, October 23, 2019 – Hamilton County Sheriff Jim Neil reports a serious injury motor vehicle crash which occurred in the rear parking lot at Moeller High School, 9001 Montgomery Road, in Sycamore Township on Wednesday October 23, 2019 at 5:40 p.m.

A 2007 Nissan Pathfinder operated by a male juvenile was traveling through the rear parking lot at Moeller High School. As the Nissan passed the Activities Center a second male juvenile climbed onto the driver side running board. That juvenile was thrown from the vehicle approximately 50 feet from the point at which he climbed on.

The juvenile thrown from the Nissan was transported to University Hospital via Air Care where he is being treated for serious injuries. Neither the driver of the Nissan nor his passenger were injured.

Alcohol and/or drugs of abuse were not factors in the crash.

All juveniles involved in the incident are students at Moeller High School.

The incident remains under investigation by the Sheriff's Traffic Safety Unit.
