VEHICLE PURSUIT ENDS IN CRASH IN ANDERSON TOWNSHIP

Anderson Township, December 26, 2019 – Hamilton County Sheriff Jim Neil reports a vehicle pursuit which resulted in a single vehicle crash at 5677 Salem Road on December 26, 2019 at 12:33pm.

At 12:20 p.m. Sheriff's Deputies were dispatched for the report of a person unconscious in a vehicle at the gas pumps located at 7580 Beechmont Avenue (Kroger). Upon officers arrival the vehicle began to pulled away. The license plate on the vehicle returned to a stolen vehicle out of Norwood. The driver, a Anna Michelle Reeves, refused to stop for deputies and a short pursuit ensued. The suspect vehicle, a 2001 black Ford Ranger, had a minor collision with another vehicle at Beechmont Avenue and Five Mile Road but continued without stopping. The pursuit traveled west on Beechmont Avenue then south on Sutton Road to west on Salem road. The driver, and lone occupant, lost control of the vehicle at 5677 Salem Road striking several mail boxes and a guard rail. The vehicle then traveled off the south side of the roadway into a creek coming to a final stop. The driver was taken into custody without further incident.

Drugs and or alcohol are believed to be a factor in the crash.

The driver was arrested for Receiving Stolen Property, Felony Fleeing and Eluding, and OVI. The suspect was taken to UC Hospital for treatment for minor injuries sustained in the crash and then transported to the Hamilton County Justice Center.
