STOLEN VEHICLE AND ARREST IN ANDERSON TOWNSHIP

Anderson Township, January 24, 2020 – Hamilton County Sheriff Jim Neil and Chief Eliot Issac of the Cincinnati Police Department report the arrest of Richard Sahlin M/W DOB 08/21/1986. Investigation began at approximately 5:15 a.m. when deputies were dispatched for a stolen vehicle at 1112 Stream Ridge Lane, in Anderson Township.

A 2014 Toyota Corolla was taken from the driveway at 1112 Stream Ridge Lane. During the investigation, the vehicle was tracked through onboard GPS. Cincinnati District 4 units responded to the area of Melrose Avenue and located the stolen vehicle. Upon approach of the vehicle, 3 subjects exited the vehicle and fled on foot. The driver of the stolen vehicle was apprehended after a short foot pursuit behind an apartment complex on Lincoln Ave .

Richard Sahlin was taken into custody by Cincinnati District 4 Units and was charged with Theft(Auto), Receiving Stolen Property, Resisting Arrest, and Obstructing Official Business. Mr. Sahlin was transported to the Hamilton County Justice Center.
