### PRISONER ESCAPE AND DEPUTY ASSAULTED

**The City of Cincinnati, April 28, 2020** – Hamilton County Sheriff Jim Neil reports that at 5:30 P.M., a prisoner was being transported to the Hamilton County Justice Center by a Corrections Deputy after receiving treatment at University Hospital. In the 2500 block of Reading Road, Delrico Oliver, male 29, date of birth November 26, 1990, of Cincinnati, was able to free himself and flee from the Sheriff's vehicle.

A foot pursuit ensued up the stairs to E. McMillan Street before the Deputy caught Oliver in the rear of the Clifton Mini Mart at 2450 Highland Avenue. During a brief struggle, the Deputy was bitten on the hand and sustained a head laceration before Oliver was taken into custody.

The Deputy was treated at University Hospital and released. Oliver was returned to the Hamilton County Justice Center without further incident. He faces additional charges of ORC 2921.34 'Escape,' and ORC 2903.13 'Assault on an Officer,' both felonies.
