Suspicious Package Found

Hamilton County Justice Center - 1000 Sycamore Street

Cincinnati Ohio, – Hamilton County Sheriff Jim Neil reports that on June 14th, 2020 at 11:47 PM, an unknown person threw a package over the concrete wall of the vehicle intake sally-port at the Hamilton County Justice Center. Due to the suspicious appearance and manner of delivery, the Sheriff's Hazardous Devices Unit was requested to examine the package. Cincinnati Police assisted by closing the surrounding streets. After evacuating the immediate area, Sheriff's HDU technicians X-rayed and disrupted the package. There were no injuries and no inmates or staff were at risk during this incident.
