Lincoln Heights Shooting

Hamilton County, June 26, 2020- Village of Lincoln Heights

Hamilton County Sheriff Jim Neil reports that on June 26, 2020 at 1:03 pm, deputies were dispatched to the street in front of 1270 Shepherd Lane in the Village of Lincoln Heights for the report of multiple shots fired. Upon arrival, officers found Demetrius Price, male/33, in a tan Toyota suffering from gunshot wounds.

Price was transported from the scene by Woodlawn EMS to the University Hospital Medical Center where he is currently in critical condition. Witnesses identified the suspects as two male blacks in a silver SUV, similar to a Dodge Durango. The suspect vehicle was last seen eastbound on Shepherd Lane fleeing the scene.
