MANDATORY MASK PROTOCOL

Cincinnati, Ohio, July 08, 2020 – On July 7, 2020, Governor Mike DeWine issued a mandate for anyone in Hamilton County to wear a mask or face covering while Hamilton County remains in a Level 3 (Red) status. The mandate will take effect today at 6:00 p.m. and will be reevaluated weekly. Governor DeWine further indicated this mandate will be enforced by state and local officials.

The Hamilton County Sheriff's Office supports the initiative to wear a mask or face covering to help prevent the further spread of the Coronavirus (COVID-19). Because is a health related order, the Hamilton County Sheriff's Office will not enforce this mandate.
