LOCKLAND MURDER: UPDATE

Village of Lockland, Hamilton County, Ohio July 10, 2020- Hamilton County Sheriff Jim Neil and Lockland Police Chief James Toles, in conjunction with Hamilton County Prosecutor Joe Deters, would like to announce the arrest and indictment of two individuals related to a recent murder that occurred in the Village of Lockland.

On May 10, 2020, Lockland officers were dispatched to the report of a person shot at 302 S. Wayne Avenue. Upon arrival officers found Mohamed Ndiaye, M/42, deceased from gunshot wounds. The Hamilton County Sheriff's Criminal Investigation Section was contacted to assist the Lockland Police Department with the investigation.

Two suspects were arrested for their part in this crime which was determined to be a botched robbery led by a prostitute who was a paid acquaintance of the victim.

George Davis, M/32, has been indicted on two counts of Promoting Prostitution a felony of the 4th degree.

Donna Sparks, F/26, has been indicted on two counts of Murder, one count of Felonious Assault and one count of Aggravated Robbery. If convicted, Sparks faces life in prison.

Both Sparks and Davis are being held in the Hamilton County Justice Center awaiting trial.
