VEHICLE PURSUIT

Columbia Township, August 8th, 2020 – Hamilton County Sheriff Jim Neil reports a vehicle pursuit in Columbia Township which started at approximately 3:54PM in the 3400 block of Highland Ave.

At 3:51PM, Hamilton County Sheriff's deputies were alerted to a theft in progress at the Home Depot 3400 Highland Ave Cincinnati, OH 45213. The suspects, an unknown male and female, entered a 2007 Dodge Caliber silver in color after being ordered to stop by responding deputies. The vehicle fled westbound Highland Ave failing to comply with signals to stop by pursuing deputies. The pursuit continued westbound Highland Ave into the City of Norwood where the suspect vehicle lost control and struck another vehicle that was stopped southbound on Montgomery Rd. There were no injuries as a result of the crash. The suspect vehicle failed to stop after the crash and continued northbound on Montgomery Rd. The pursuit was terminated in the 6000 block of Montgomery Rd. The pursuit reached speeds of approximately 45-50 mph, lasted approximately four minutes, and was 3.7 miles in length before termination.

The non-injury crash remains under investigation by the Hamilton County Sheriff's Office Traffic Safety Section. The Theft and Failure to Comply remains under investigation by the Criminal Investigative Section.
