BICYCLIST STRUCK IN HIT SKIP AUTO CRASH

The City of Forest Park, August 13, 2020 – Hamilton County Sheriff Jim Neil and The City of Forest Park Police Chief William Arns report that at 9:24 P.M. a seventeen-year old male was operating a motorized bicycle with no lights southbound on Winton Road approaching the intersection of Sharon Road when he was struck by a white pick-up truck. The juvenile was ejected from his bicycle which was trapped underneath the truck and was dragged several thousand feet to the intersection of Damon Road where it was later located on the side of the road.

The juvenile bicyclist was transported to the hospital for non-life threatening injuries. The truck was last observed fleeing southbound on Winton Road.
