TRAFFIC PURSUIT IN AMBERLEY VILLAGE

Amberley Village, October 27, 2020 – Hamilton County Sheriff Jim Neil and Amberley Village Police Chief Rich Wallace report that at approximately 3:53 P.M.. Amberley Village Police attempted to stop a 2009 Lincoln for multiple traffic and equipment violations near the intersection of Ridge Road and East Galbraith Road. After the vehicle failed to stop and was observed throwing a handgun out the window, a traffic pursuit ensued across multiple jurisdictions. Hamilton County Sheriff's Deputies became involved as the pursuit approached the Village of Lincoln Heights and the pursuit continued further, eventually terminating when the suspect ran a red traffic signal northbound Kenn Road at West Kemper Road where he struck a 2008 Honda Civic.

The suspect was quickly taken into custody without further incident. Non-life threatening injuries were reported in the auto crash and both vehicle operators were transported to the hospital for evaluation. Multiple charges are pending on the suspect; due to the ongoing investigation his information will be released at a later time. The pursuit traveled approximately six miles and lasted ten minutes.
