### Vehicle Pursuit in Crosby Township

**Crosby Township, October 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2020** – Hamilton County Sheriff Jim Neil reports a vehicle pursuit that occurred in Crosby Township. At 10:14 P.M., Deputies were dispatched to the 10800 block of Hamilton Cleves Road for a suspicious vehicle which was upgraded to a burglary in progress shortly after. A Hamilton County Sheriff's Deputy observed a vehicle matching the description of the suspicious vehicle leaving the area of the reported attempt burglary. The Deputy attempted to initiate a traffic stop on the vehicle. The operator of the 2011 Infiniti G25X refused to comply with the Deputy's signals to stop and continued southbound on Hamilton Cleves Road. The pursuit changed direction turning onto westbound New Haven Road. City of Harrison Police officers deployed Stop-Sticks in the area of New Haven Road and Radcliffe Drive effectively puncturing the tires of the fleeing vehicle. The fleeing vehicle stopped on New Haven Road and Progress Way. The operator, Natasha Taylor, female 22, was taken into custody without further incident. An investigation determined that the 2011 Infiniti G25X was allegedly stolen out of Frankfort, Kentucky on September 24<sup>th</sup>, 2020.

No injuries occurred as a result of the pursuit that was approximately 6.6 miles in length and lasted approximately 9 minutes. Natasha Taylor was charged with Receiving Stolen Property 2913.51 Felony of the 4<sup>th</sup> degree and Failure to Comply with Order or Signal of Police Officer 2921.331 Felony of the 3<sup>rd</sup> degree.
