Additional Victims Identified across the United States

Cincinnati, October 8, 2020- The Regional Electronics & Computer Investigations task force has identified 3 additional victims from across the United States relating to the arrest of Christopher Alvin Muldrow. The investigation is pertaining to Muldrow's internet activities and investigators believe there are possibly more victims that have not been identified.

Cincinnati, October 7, 2020 – Hamilton County Sheriff Jim Neil reports the arrest of Christopher Alvin Muldrow, M/B/33 (DOB 12/13/1986). Muldrow is being charged with 4 counts of "Pandering Obscenity Involving a Minor." All charges are felonies of the second degree.

Members of the Regional Electronics & Computer Investigations section initiated an investigation into the online internet activities of Muldrow after receiving a tip through their partnership with the nationwide taskforce, "Internet Crimes Against Children (I.C.A.C.)."

Muldrow was arrested without incident on today's date and is currently being held at the Hamilton County Justice Center. The investigation pertaining to
