Suspect Identified and Wanted in Double Shooting in Whitewater Township

October 20, 2020-Hamilton County Sheriff Jim Neil reports that a suspect has been identified related to the double shooting in Whitewater Township. The suspect has been identified as Brian James Jackson. Mr. Jackson is a 23 year old white male, 5'11", 160lbs, with brown hair and brown eyes. Jackson is known to frequent the Whitewater, Harrison, Crosby Township areas of Hamilton County as well as southeastern Indiana neighborhoods of Lawrenceburg and Greendale. Warrants have been signed and we are asking for the public's help in trying to locate this wanted person.

Mr. Jackson is wanted on two counts of Felonious Assault (2nd degree Felony and one count of Firing a Weapon into a Habitation (2nd degree Felony).

Whitewater Township, October 17, 2020 – Hamilton County Sheriff Jim Neil reports a double shooting that took place on Shore Lane in Whitewater Township late in the evening of October 16, 2020. Two people John Polly M/59 and Chris Black M/36 were shot multiple times by an unknown assailant(s). Mr. Polly and Mr.
