SERIOUS INJURY HIT-SKIP CRASH IN WHITEWATER TOWNSHIP

Whitewater Township, November 5th, 2020 – Hamilton County Sheriff Jim Neil reports a serious injury crash involving a semi truck which struck a bicyclist and then fled the scene in the 4900 block of SR-128 in Whitewater Township on Wednesday, November 4th, 2020 at 8:40pm.

Ron E. Miller, male, age 44, of North Bend, Ohio was operating a Trek Bicycle southbound and on the shoulder in the 4900 block of SR-128 (Hamilton Cleves Road). An unknown make and model semi truck was also operating southbound at the same location. At this point, as the semi truck was passing Miller on the left, it struck him on his left side. Miller sustained serious injuries the night of the crash and was flown to the University of Cincinnati Medical Center where he is listed in stable condition. After striking Miller, the semi truck left the scene without stopping. The semi truck will likely have damage to its right front wheel and side.

The Hamilton County Sheriff's Office Traffic Safety Unit is investigating the crash and we are asking for the assistance of the public in identifying the semi truck and its operator.
