Murder in the Village of Woodlawn

Village of Woodlawn, November 5, 2020th – Hamilton County Sheriff Jim Neil along with Village of Woodlawn Police Chief Aaron Tillman III report that on November 5th, 2020 at approximately 7:53pm, Woodlawn Officers were dispatched to a person shot at 10267 Panola Drive. Responding officers found Tracey Ford-Hammons, female age 58, suffering from gunshot wounds outside of this address.

The Hamilton County Sheriff's Office Criminal Investigative Section was requested by Chief Tillman to assist his officers with this investigation.

Mrs. Ford-Hammons was transported to the University of Cincinnati Medical Center where she was pronounced deceased.

Witnesses report seeing a male subject with light complexion wearing dark colored pants and a dark colored shirt flee the scene on foot and possibly enter a red sedan which then left the area at a high rate of speed.
