Firearm Discharged Into a Residence

10000 block of Able Ct.

The Village of Lincoln Heights, December 2, 2020 – Hamilton County Sheriff Jim Neil reports the arrest of Jordan Brown, a 23 year old male, for firing a handgun from a vehicle several times in the 10000 block of Able Court in the Village of Lincoln Heights. Brown was witnessed firing the weapon from inside a vehicle a few minutes after midnight. The rounds struck the victims unoccupied vehicle and an occupied apartment building. Brown then fled the scene in a black Dodge Charger. Fortunately no one was injured as a result of this offense.

Officers from Woodlawn Police Department observed the vehicle leaving the area and apprehended the suspect with assistance from surrounding law enforcement agencies. The handgun believed to have been used in the offense was later found along the roadside near where Brown was first observed by law enforcement. Sheriff's Deputies and Detectives collected evidence from the scene and the involved vehicles. Brown was charged with aggravated menacing, discharging a firearm into a habitation and criminal damaging.

Thanks to the quick assistance of the Woodlawn Police and surrounding agencies, the suspect was apprehended without incident and evidence was recovered before it could be lost or destroyed.
