Regional Enforcement Narcotics Unit Agents Seize Guns and Drugs in Recent Bust

Hamilton County, Ohio, July 12, 2021 – Agents from the Hamilton County Sheriff's Regional Enforcement Narcotics Units (RENU) along with the U.S. Department of Homeland Security, Homeland Security Investigations (HSI), seized nearly four pounds of fentanyl, seven firearms, and nearly ten thousand dollars cash in a search warrant in Green Township on Thursday, July 8th.

Randy Dangerfield Jr., M/B/24, is facing once count each of Drug Possession and Drug Trafficking, both felonies of the first degree, after agents searched his residence located at 5592 Sunnywood Lane, in Green Township. That search warrant yielded the discovery of 1,719 grams of fentanyl; \$9,567 US currency; and seven firearms, two of which have been confirmed to be stolen. Dangerfield Jr. is currently being held at the Hamilton County Justice Center.

The Hamilton County Sheriff's Regional Enforcement Narcotics Unit is comprised of investigators with the Hamilton County Sheriff's Department, the Green Township Police Department, and the Cheviot Police Department.
