Slow Down for Safe Holiday Shopping

HCSO increasing patrols for the shopping season

Hamilton County, OH, December 2nd, 2021 – The Hamilton County Sheriff's Office wants everyone to be safe this holiday season. With that in mind, HCSO is taking the initiative to increase patrol visibility with the purpose of making the commute safer for the public. Because the holiday season is the biggest shopping season of the year, more drivers will be on the roads than usual, increasing the likelihood of a motor vehicle crash. During this holiday season, it is more important than ever to slow down.

During the month of December in 2019, there were more than 2,500 vehicle crashes in Hamilton County. During the same time period in 2020, there were close to 2,300 crashes in Hamilton County. Many of these crashes could be avoided if we give ourselves more time to get to the places we are going and SLOW DOWN.

The Hamilton County Sheriff's Office will be targeting locations throughout Hamilton County where the largest number of crashes occur. This traffic blitz will occur starting on December 6th and continue through the holiday shopping season.
